Introduction

Versantis AG values your privacy. This Privacy Policy demonstrates our commitment to protect and respect your personal data when you use our website.

Personal data we process

The personal data we process about you may include:

- your name and contact details (such as name, postal address, phone number or email address) and other basic information;
- information, such as, your IP address and other information collected from your visits to our website;
- identification and background information provided by you or collected as part of our on-boarding process;
- any other information relating to you which you may provide to us.

How we process your personal data

We process your personal data:

- to communicate with you;
- to administer our relationship with you;
- to provide and improve our services to you;
- to provide and improve our website.

Purposes for processing your personal data

We only use your personal data, if it is permissible by law. These “Permitted Uses” may include:

- providing our services;
- complying with legal and regulatory obligations;
- exercising or defending of legal claims or proceedings;
- processing that is necessary for purposes of legitimate interests of the firm or third parties including the interests set out above; and/or based on consent.

Who we share your personal data with

We may share your personal data with trusted third parties including:

- suppliers to whom we outsource certain support services;
- IT service providers;
- accountants;
- third parties engaged in the course of the development of our products or services we provide to clients.

For the purposes set out in this Statement and where necessary, we may share personal data with courts, regulatory authorities, government agencies and law enforcement agencies. We may also be required to disclose your personal data to comply with legal or regulatory requirements.

Data collection on our website / Server log files

When visiting our website, we automatically collect and store for a limited time log data and device information. That information includes, among other things, details about how you use our website, IP address, access dates and times, hardware and software information, device information and similar information. We may process that data on the basis that it is required for us to operate, maintain and improve our websites.

Handling contact requests

When contacting us via our contact form, user details will be stored for the purpose of processing the request as well as in the event that follow-up questions arise. We will not share these data without your consent.

Countries we transfer your personal data to

We may transfer your personal data to recipients abroad, including in countries that do not provide the same level of protection as Swiss law. We will usually do so on the basis that such a transfer is necessary for the performance of an agreement with the data subject(s), for an agreement or performance of an agreement concluded in the interest of the data subject, or for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims.

Protecting your personal data

We use various technical and organizational security measures to help protect your personal data from unauthorized access, use, disclosure, alteration or destruction.

When using a service on our website, your personal data will be transmitted to us. In order for those not to fall into the wrong hands, we encrypt them using the SSL method (Secure Socket Layer). The SSL method is currently the most common and secure data transmission method on the Internet. SSL is used every time you see a small lock on your browser's status bar.

Retaining your personal data

We retain your personal data for as long as it is necessary for the purposes for which the data is collected, and as long as we have a legitimate interest in keeping personal data, for example to enforce or defend claims or for archiving purposes and IT security. We also retain your personal data as long as it is subject to a legal retention obligation.

Use of services by third parties

It may happen that content by third parties, such as videos from YouTube, maps from Google Maps or graphics from other websites are included as part of this online service. This always presupposes that the providers of these contents (hereinafter referred to as "third party providers") detect the users' IP address. For without the IP address, they could not send the content to the browser of the respective user. The display of these contents therefore requires the IP address. We attempt to use only content whose respective providers use the IP address solely for content delivery. However, it is outside our sphere of influence whether third parties store the IP address for e.g. statistical purposes.

Cookies

In order to make your visit to the website appealing and to enable the use of certain functions, the website uses so-called cookies on various pages. These are small text files stored on your device (for example, mobile phone, tablet, PC). Some of the used cookies are deleted following any given browser session, i.e. after closing your browser (so-called session cookies). Other cookies remain on your device and make it possible to recognize your browser upon your next visit (so-called persistent cookies). You can set your browser in such a way as to being informed about the placement of cookies and you can decide for yourself about their acceptance; or you can reject them by default. We hereby point out that the functionality and the comfort of use might be reduced when disabling cookies. For more information visit:

Use of web fonts

These website use external fonts, i.e. Google Fonts. Google Fonts is a service by Google Inc. ("Google"). The integration of these web fonts occurs via a server call, usually a Google server in the USA. This transmits to the server, that you have visited our website.
